# A NEW TOWN

between Pulaski and Bonduel  
to be Platted by W. C. Zachow.

A week or so ago, THE ADVOCATE stated that a new town would probably be platted on the new line of the Northwestern between Bonduel and Pulaski. This week we can state for sure that a new town will be started. W. C. Zachow last week purchased eighty acres of land in the town of Angelica, on the new right-of-way. He has sold fourteen acres to the railroad company for depot site and side-tracks. The balance will be platted in the near future and lots sold. THE ADVOCATE would suggest that the new town be called Zachow. It will be located in a rich farming country and will make a good town. We have been informed that if anyone desires a good place to start a store of any kind, elevator, or go into business in a new town, correspond with Mr. Zachow. The road may be built that early this year.
