

TRAIN WRECK AT ZACHOW — The east bound Chicago North Western 5:30 a.m. freight train was derailed last Saturday at Zachow. Although no one was injured, ten cars went off the track with nine of them being either piled up or shoved into the ditch along the tracks. The engine did not leave the track although the car next to it was the first one to leave and tracks and evidently caused the wreck. A hot box on the axle was believed to be the cause of the piled up. The top picture shows the cars on the north side of the track while the other picture shows two gondola type cars on the south side that were carrying pulp wood. There were over 100 cars being pulled by the diesel engine. The tracks were cleared and train service restored after about 15 hours.
